

A SPECIAL MESSAGE ABOUT SPLOST IV FROM NORTH SPRINGS PTSA:

On November 8, each of us will have the opportunity to vote on SPLOST IV. Indications are that **your vote to approve** continuing the penny sales tax to fund needed improvements to Fulton County Schools **will be critical**. All North Fulton PTA's have signed a letter in support of SPLOST IV. With SPLOST IV funds, all schools in the North Springs Cluster, except the recently built Ison Springs Elementary, will receive needed building renovations. All Fulton County Schools will also benefit from technology improvements to meet educational standards, improved security equipment, and bus purchases. The sales tax revenue also will be used to service bond debt predating 1997. While these capital improvement needs can be funded through increased property tax, for the past decade Fulton County residents have instead voted to renew the penny sales tax. Through this funding method all residents and visitors to Fulton County contribute, including the city of Atlanta, as the sales tax is applied to the entire county. **Please join your fellow parent and teacher members by making it a priority to vote for SPLOST IV on November 8.**
